## Athletic Director's Report: Reported by Jesse Smith.

A lot going on. Big weekend this weekend. Football game moved to Whitman our field is a mess from all the rains. Whitman turf field is amazing. Saturday Boys Cross Country will be in States and Cheerleaders will be at States at Hartford CC. Field Hockey lost in State semi's but three years in a row with State Regional title. Boys soccer lost to Whitman. Info. going out soon to address hazing that just happened at Damascus. Addressing it and working with all coaches to ensure that doesn't occur here.
Two requests: Sideline turf protector on side lines for lacrosse teams and will help soccer teams. Protects sidelines and doesn't tear up grass. Had to do a lot of sodding this summer for repairs to this area. When we get new track done we will need it on track to place under benches for soccer team. Looking to use it for Field Hockey for their sidelines as well. Cost is $\$ 2400$. Company will put logo on it.

Vote on approval of $\$ 2444$ for custom side line turf protectors to be used by soccer, lacrosse and field hockey. Vote passes with no objections.

Wants us to think about getting a new mascot costume. Current mascot (Jake) is really doing a great job with it. Feet and hands are all torn up. (passed around current proposed costume). Doesn't want Boosters to fund the whole thing, maybe get SGA, and some fundraising to fund the whole thing. Total cost is about $\$ 4000.00$. Maybe have all teams contribute $\$ 50-\$ 100$ each.

Other big expenses coming up. Lacrosse netting system behind the net. Sleeves are in ground, poles goes in sleeves. Less moving around and less likely to fall down.

May need fan buses for football. Buses are about $\$ 250$ each bus. Wants 2 buses. Usually only want buses when we go to states but since this game had to be moved want to be able to shuttle as many kids as possible over.

Comment: Could be do something at Gala to get donations for new Mascot uniform. Captive audience.
Comment: Use mascot to do outside events.
Maybe do 50/50 raffle at Gala for new Mascot costume.
Introduction of new Principal Ms. Heckert.
