MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: President Mark Green called the meeting to order.

CONCESSIONS: Mary Vargo informed everyone that she is having trouble getting the JV boys basketball parents to work the concession stand for the boys' basketball senior night game on February 22nd. Mary to send an email to Suzanne Weiss which she will put out on Boosters website to see if anyone would like to step forward and help out.

MEMBERSHIP: Ariane Promisel said that membership is currently at the number it was at the end of last year, and this is leading into spring season. Chris Byrne said she still has enough giveaways to last through spring season.

FIELDS: Les Ulanow said the fields look great. He said there was talk about bidding out, but Game Day is so great, they are the "go to" company and less expensive than the competition.

SCHOOL STORE: Linda Pollekoff said that she is in the process of setting up an online store, Fieldhouse.com, to be used as an online supplement to the school store. This will allow the school store to cut down on their inventory, and percentage of the sales goes back to Boosters. It should be up and running in a couple of weeks.

WINTER /SPRING CAPTAINS/COACHES LUNCH: This is scheduled for April 6th. Winter lunch never happened because it was a snow day.

NEW BUSINESS: Wayne Olan introduced the idea of parents purchasing replicas of their kids' jerseys as a fundraising opportunity.
